Euphorbia spp

Common name:

Spurge, Milkweed, Poinsettia, Caustic bush,

Palatability to Livestock:

Not known to be eaten.

Toxicity to Goats:

Low risk.

Toxicity to Other Species:

Potentially toxic to all animal species.

Poisonous Principle:

- . Diterpines, Cyanogenetic glycocides,
- . Euphorbone,
- . Unknown compounds.

Effects:

Signs and symptoms;

- . Latex causes dermatitis, caustic to the skin and eyes, causing temporary blindness.
- . Fruits are purgative and toxic.
- . Nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, delirium.

Health and Production Problems;

- . Toxins may be found in the milk of goats who have eaten this weed.
- . Sometimes causes sudden death, with no other signs.

Treatment;

. Induce vomiting, in non-ruminants, then try activated charcoal.

Integrated Control Strategy:

- . Herbicides, Group C. Do not feed to any livestock.
- . Be aware of potential stock problems.
- . Proclaimed "Noxious" in some states.

Comments:

. Cases of poisoning attributable to this spp are rare.

- . Erect annual or biennial herbs, exuding white sap, spread by seed. Often very spiny.
- . Leaves are varied, all exuding milky sap.
- . Flowers are small with no petals, usually red, to yellow, to orange, or creamy white.
- . Clustered in small cup like shapes, often surrounded by attractive bracts.
- . Fruits are borne on stalks protruding from the flower.
- . Livestock poisoning usually occurs after eating contaminated hay.
- . All parts are dangerous.
- . Use methylated spirits to remove latex, <u>not</u> water and soap,
