

Lycium ferocissimum

Common name:

African boxthorn, Boxthorn,

Palatability to Livestock:

Moderate at all stages.

Toxicity to Goats:

Low.

Toxicity to Other Species:

May be toxic to some livestock.

Poisonous Principle:

- . Hyocyamine, and other alkaloids,
- . Atropine, alkaloids.

Effects:

Signs and symptoms;

- . May produce narcotic symptoms,
- . Drowsy, dilated pupils, thirst,
- . Unconsciousness.

Health and Production Problems;

- . Be aware of potential livestock problems.

Treatment;

- . See Vet.

Integrated Control Strategy:

- . Dense thickets should be grazed by goats.
- . Chain out and burn.
- . Paint stumps with herbicide.
- . Spray when bushes are actively growing, prior to, or at flowering.
- . Adequate soil moisture should be available to ensure herbicide is taken up.
- . Declared “Noxious” in most states.

Comments:

- . Shrub up to 4 metres high, with tangled long, rigid, branches, ending in stout spines.
- . Leaves are oval, in clusters, along branches and at base of spines, bright green slightly fleshy, rounded at the tip, sometimes deciduous in winter.

- . Flowers are pale lilac to white, single or in pairs, fragrant, usually in spring and summer, but maybe all year round.
- . Berries dull orange-red, shiny, round one cm in diameter.
- . Declared “Noxious” for all NSW.
- . Reproduction is by seeds and suckers from root fragments.
- . Growth is initially slow, but improves when the root system is developed.
- . Regenerates rapidly after fire, and when top growth is cut.
- . Native of S Africa, usually grown as a hedge plant, naturalized in all states.
- . Found in all States of Australia, under all conditions.
